NOTICE TO RESIDENTS OF THE VILLAS HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION

The City of San Dimas has been informed that there are a number of dogs in your community that at times are off leash in public. This is a reminder that the City has an Ordinance that prohibits any dog from being off a leash on public property or on the private property of others (SDMC 6.12.030). This Ordinance is for the protection of the community and the safety of the dog. This is especially important for a community such as yours where you are adjacent to areas that are home to wildlife including coyotes and snakes. A violation of the leash Ordinance may be subject to citation.

The City encourages all residents to be responsible dog owners by:

- Making sure that your property is secure so as to not allow your dog to escape from your property.
- When walking your dog that they remain on a leash.
- Picking up after your dog while on walks.

If you should encounter a stray or off leash dog please contact the Inland Valley Humane Society at (909) 623-9777. If you should encounter or are attacked by an aggressive off leash dog you should immediately contact the San Dimas Sheriff Station (909) 450-2700.
